Subject: Taxability of Moving Expense Reimbursement Effective January 1, 2018

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (P.L. 115-97) that was signed into law on December 22, 2017 impacts the taxability of moving expense reimbursements provided by an employer. Reimbursements for moving expenses made to employees or paid directly to third parties by the employer on and after January 1, 2018 are included in wage income subject to federal income tax withholding, and FICA.<sup>1</sup>

Please note that California is one of a few states that utilize a selective approach to conformity with changes to the Internal Revenue Code. The Franchise Tax Board has not yet published conforming Internal Revenue Code sections as of January 1, 2018 for state income tax purposes.

We are awaiting further guidance from the IRS and will discuss policy changes with appropriate campus stakeholders during the next few months. Business and Finance Bulletin G-13, *Policy and Regulations Governing Moving and Relocation*, will be revised to reflect any policy changes resulting from the impact of tax reform legislation at the next update.
